Theatre Requirements

Auditions for the theatre arts magnet will take place virtually this year due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The format for all applicants will be fully taped video to be submitted no later than their assigned date. We will then make contact to arrange a virtual meeting/interview, so please ensure the email addresses on your application are accurate.

AUDITION PROCEDURES

1. Introduction: Begin by stating the following information, directly to camera:

Name

Age

Elementary school presently attending

Why you want to be part of the Husky Theatre Arts Magnet Program

2. Monologue: Perform an age-appropriate monologue from a published theatre work. The monologue may be either comedic or dramatic, but must not exceed one minute in length. Judges will be looking for honesty, focus, naturalness, and vocal projection. Poetry, fiction, screenplays, and lyrics will not be allowed.

3. Optional: Sing 16 bars (around 30 seconds) of a song from a Broadway musical. It can be any character from any show, but must not include any “adult” words or themes. You may use accompaniment or sing the piece acapella.

4. Interview: We will arrange to have a 5-10 minute virtual session to get to know you better. Be ready to tell us a little bit about yourself!

5. Photo: Please submit a clear, recent (within the last month) photo of yourself against a plain background, looking directly at the camera. It can be taken with a phone, etc.

Please submit the entire audition as one file. You may stop recording in between segments and edit them together, or you may do one continuous take – whatever works best for you. Please make sure you are well lit, can see your eyes, and that we can hear you clearly. We’re looking forward to seeing your brilliant talent! Break a leg!
